

Car Camping Rules

These Rules apply to the Car Camping area for the 2024 edition of Electric Castle Festival.

All times and information on this page are subject to change without notice.

All campers are expected to behave in a manner that is courteous to other campers. Campers will be searched on check-in.

Prepare your campsite by sealing, securing or dismantling any structures or items that may be affected as heavy rains are common in Bonțida.

The organizers are not responsible for any materials misplaced, lost or stolen. It is recommended that you do not bring valuable items. If you do bring valuable items, please lock them in your car. Do not leave valuable items in your tent. All of your items must stay within the marked lines.

In order to accommodate all vehicles, you must park in the assigned area (3x8 meters). Attempting to park anywhere else creates a significant disruption that negatively impacts everyone's comfort and safety.

Multiple cars wishing to park in sites next to each other must arrive at the same time. Plan on meeting up prior to driving into camping. It is essential that the entire group drives into the search area together. There is no saving spots.

As your cars proceed through search, you can continue into a limited-time waiting area. Once the entire group arrives in the waiting area, you may proceed to the lanes to enter the camping lots. Camping staff will try their best to accommodate directing your group to an appropriate location. Let them know how many cars are part of your group.

Once you are parked in a camping spot, you won't be allowed to move your vehicle for the duration of the festival. If you need to leave early and do not plan on returning to the festival, please let security know so that they can help direct you out safely.

Once a vehicle vacates its spot, the site is considered relinquished. A new entry for your car in this area will require a new Car Camping ticket. Any items remaining in the campsite will be collected by our Lost & Found team and you can recover them in the first week after the festival.

Starting the engine during the night is restricted in the Car Camping and RV Camping areas. No motorcycles, RVs, trailers, motorhomes, buses or trucks will be allowed. We do not allow vehicles with showers, sink, toilet or stove inside/attached to the vehicle. Electric generators are not permitted. **The use of outdoor cooking appliances is not permitted in EC Village.**

! To get access to the Car Camping lots, every vehicle will need a Car Camping ticket. Every person from one vehicle will need to own a **valid festival pass** and a **valid camping pass**. Access is allowed with a **maximum of 5 persons** inside the vehicle.
