



## Car Camping Regulations

**These rules apply to the Car Camping area within Electric Castle Festival, 2026 edition.**

All times and information on this page are subject to change without notice.

All participants are expected to behave politely towards other participants in the Car Camping area. People accommodated in this area will be checked at the checkpoint.

Prepare your camping spot by sealing, securing, or dismantling any structures or objects that could be affected. Heavy rains are common in Bonțida.

The organizers are not responsible for moved, lost, or stolen materials. It is recommended not to bring valuables. If you bring valuables, please lock them inside the car. Do not leave valuables in the tent. All items must remain within the marked lines.

To accommodate all vehicles, you must park in the designated areas (3x8 meters). Attempting to park anywhere else creates a blockage in the accommodation flow, which negatively impacts everyone's comfort and safety.

Cars that wish to park next to each other must arrive at the same time. Plan your meeting before arriving at the campsite. It is essential that the entire group arrives together in the area you want. There are no spot reservations.

As cars pass through the check, you may proceed to a limited-time waiting area. Once the entire group arrives in the waiting area, you may move onto the lanes to enter the



camping spots. The camping staff will do their best to help direct your group to a suitable location. Tell them how many cars are in your group.

For your safety and that of your neighbors, once you are parked in an area, it is not possible to move the vehicle for the entire duration of the festival. If you need to leave early and do not intend to return to the festival, please inform security so they can guide you to exit safely.

Once a vehicle leaves its spot, the area is considered void. A new entry into this area requires a new **Car Camping** ticket. Any items left in the camping area will be collected by our Lost & Found team and can be recovered during the first week after the festival.

! The ticket dedicated to the Car Camping area can only be purchased for the entire duration of the festival (5 nights).

**Starting the vehicle engine during the entire stay in the Car Camping area is restricted.** Motorcycles, RVs, trailers, motorhomes, buses, or trucks are not allowed. We do not allow vehicles with a shower, sink, toilet, or stove inside/attached to the vehicle. Electric generators of any kind are not permitted. **The use of outdoor cooking appliances is not allowed in the EC Village areas.**



Below are some examples of vehicles permitted in the Car Camping areas.



! To access Car Camping, each vehicle will need a Car Camping ticket. Each person in the vehicle must hold a **valid Camping pass**. **A maximum of 5 people** are allowed per vehicle.
