



RV Camping Regulations

These rules apply to the RV Camping area within Electric Castle Festival, 2026 edition.

All times and information on this page are subject to change without notice.

All participants are expected to behave politely towards other participants in the RV Camping area. People accommodated in this area will be checked at the checkpoint. The RV Camping ticket allows you to park in a dedicated area within EC Village.

The organizers are not responsible for moved, lost, or stolen materials. It is recommended not to bring valuables. If you bring valuables, please lock them inside the RV. All items must remain within the RV's designated space.

The Organizer reserves the right to modify this Regulation at any time, without prior notice to the Participant. Any modification of this Regulation will be displayed on the event website www.electriccastle.com.

By purchasing a ticket and/or by accessing the Festival, and/or by creating an account on the website electriccastle.com, the Participant declares that they have read, understood, and agree to comply with this Regulation.

! RV Camping spots are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Motorhomes will be parked in the RV Camping area. Cars will be parked in the festival parking lot.



Included in the RV Camping ticket:

- power source (10Ah)
- water source (for which you will need a hose)
- grey water disposal area
- chemical toilet disposal point

! To access RV Camping, each RV will need an RV Camping ticket. Each person in the RV must hold a **valid Camping pass**.

! The ticket dedicated to the RV Camping area can only be purchased for the entire duration of the festival (5 nights).

To accommodate all RVs, you must park in the designated areas. Attempting to park anywhere else creates a blockage in the accommodation flow, which negatively impacts everyone's comfort and safety.

RVs that wish to park next to each other must arrive at the same time. Plan your meeting before arriving at the campsite. It is essential that the entire group arrives together in the area you want. There are no spot reservations.

As RVs pass through the check, you may proceed to a limited-time waiting area. Once the entire group arrives in the waiting area, you may move onto the lanes to enter the camping spots. The camping staff will do their best to help direct your group to a suitable location. Tell them how many RVs are in your group.

For your safety and that of your neighbors, once you are parked in an area, it is not possible to move the RV for the entire duration of the festival. If you need to leave early and do not intend to return to the festival, please inform security so they can guide you to exit safely.



Once an RV leaves its spot, the area is considered void. A new entry into this area requires a new RV Camping ticket. Any items left in the camping area will be collected by our Lost & Found team and can be recovered during the first week after the festival. The RV Camping ticket ensures a single entry for the motorhome and an unlimited number of entries for the participants staying in the RV.

Starting the motorhome engine during the entire stay in the RV camping area is restricted. Motorcycles, trailers, cars, buses, or trucks are not allowed. Electric generators of any kind are not permitted. **The use of outdoor cooking appliances is not allowed in the EC Village areas.** Bringing food and water in sealed plastic bottles is permitted.
