

RV Camping Rules

These Rules apply to the RV Camping area for the 2024 edition of Electric Castle Festival.

All times and information on this page are subject to change without notice.

All campers are expected to behave in a manner that is courteous to other campers. Campers will be searched on check-in.

The organizers are not responsible for any materials misplaced, lost or stolen. It is recommended that you do not bring valuable items. If you do bring valuable items, please lock them in your RV. All of your items must stay within the marked lines.

The Organizer has the right to modify the regulations whenever, without a preliminary notice of the Participant. Any modification will be displayed on the Organizer's website www.electriccastle.com. The modification is of immediate application starting with the moment of publication.

By purchasing the ticket, entering the Festival or by creating an account on the electriccastle.com website, the Participant declares that he/she read, understood and obliged himself/herself to respect the current regulations.

! Places in RV Camping are allocated in the order of arrival. RVs will be parked in RV Camping. Cars will be parked in Car Camping.

The RV Camping ticket includes:

- power source (10Ah)
- water source nearby (you will need your own hose)
- wastewater discharge
- chemical toilet discharge

! To get access to the RV Camping lots, every RV will need a RV Camping ticket. Every person from inside the RV will need to own a valid festival pass and a valid camping pass.

! The RV camping ticket can only be purchased for the entire duration of the festival (5 nights).

To accommodate all RVs, you must park in designated areas. Trying to park anywhere else creates a bottleneck in the flow of accommodations, which has a negative impact on everyone's comfort and safety.

RVs wishing to park side by side must arrive at the same time. Plan the meeting before you arrive at the campsite. It is essential that the whole group gets to the area you want together. There are no seat reservations.

As the RVs go through inspection, you can proceed in a time-limited waiting area. Once the entire group arrives at the waiting area, you can walk down the lanes to enter the campsites. Campsite staff will do their best to assist you in directing your group to a suitable location. Tell them how many RVs are in your group.

For your safety and that of your neighbors, once you are parked in an area, it is not possible to move your RV for the duration of the festival. If you need to leave early and do not intend to return to the festival, please let security know so they can direct you to a safe exit.

Once an RV leaves its spot, the zone is considered void. A new entry to this area requires a new RV Camping ticket. Any items left in the campsite will be collected by our Lost & Found team and you can retrieve them in the first week after the festival. The RV Camping ticket provides one entry for the camper and unlimited entries for participants living in the RV.

Starting the motorhome engine at night is restricted. No motorcycles, trailers, cars, buses or trucks will be allowed. Electric generators of any kind are not permitted. **The use of outdoor cooking appliances is not permitted in EC Village areas.** Access with food and water in sealed plastic bottles is allowed.
